Reflection

Questions of the day... As I was leaving the store the other day, I noticed a lady putting her groceries in her car. When she was finished, she put the cart directly behind another vehicle. Now, that person would have to move it to get out of their parking space. At first, I was so tempted to push the cart behind the lady's car, but I didn't. As I was walking back to my car, I tried to figure out why she couldn't push the empty cart to the location where you can leave your cart. Have we become so focused on ourselves that we really don't care about anybody else? I'm sure if I put the cart behind her car there would be lots of anger, frustration and who knows what else! Is it so hard to be considerate of others these days?

A suggestion when reading scripture, read it slowly. After a couple of verses, stop reading and think about the words we just read. Do they stir some emotion in us? Can we picture ourselves in the scene? To get closer to God, we must hear what He is telling us in the scripture, and the message may be different for each one of us.

With this in mind, I will give you a few suggestions from today's readings. In the first reading from Sirach, "one's faults when one speaks." How many times do we hear people say things that make us wonder what are they thinking?

Psalms 92, we said, "Lord, it is good to give thanks to you." How many times do we thank the Lord for simple things like going somewhere and getting there safely? If we counted how many times we thank Jesus versus asking Him for something, which would be the higher number?

In First Corinthians the last line is, "knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain." Do we believe this, especially in challenging times? Or do we tell Jesus about our frustration and our disappointment? In Luke's gospel, the line, "from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks." How many times do we judge others or correct them without thinking about our own lives first?

Remember the bible is the **Basic Instruction Before Leaving Earth!**
