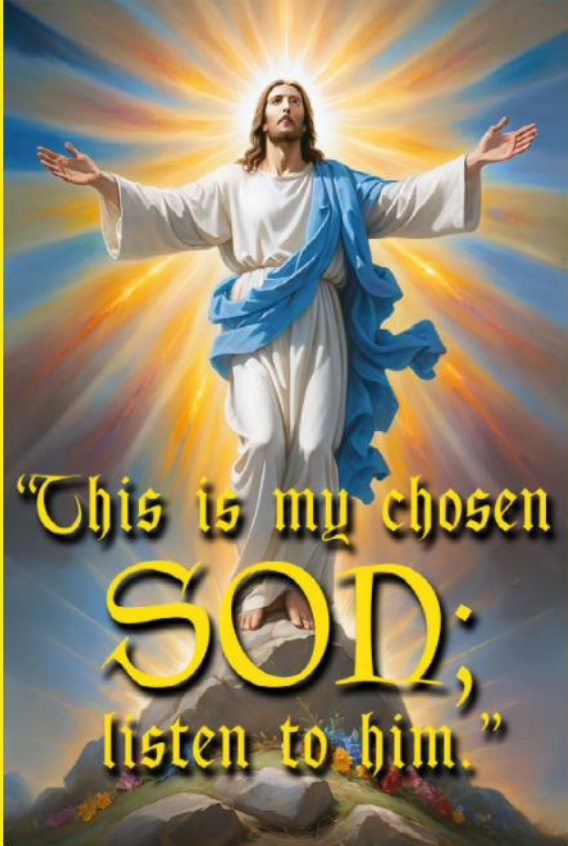

In Genesis, Abram put his faith in the Lord. He did as God had told him and he was blessed with many descendants. When we read the bible, we hear many stories about people having faith and their request being granted.
